It Happened This Week!



● **Super Bowl XLIII**—which pitted the Pittsburgh Steelers against the Arizona Cardinals—scored 98.7 million viewers in 2009, making it the most-watched Super Bowl ever. The Steelers won the game, 27-23. It was the number-two telecast of all time, exceeded only by the 1963 series finale of *M*A*S*H*, which drew a whopping 106 million viewers!

● **John Huston directed Marilyn Monroe** in her final film, *The Misfits*, in 1961. Arthur Miller, Monroe's husband at the time, wrote the screenplay. In 1999, a sleeveless black silk cocktail dress that the legendary actress wore for her role as a depressed divorcee sold at auction for \$72,900!



● **"Crocodile Rock"** landed Elton John at the top of the U.S. pop charts for the first time in 1973. Elton's last number-one hit, "Candle in the Wind," is reportedly the most popular single of all time, with more than 33 million copies sold!

● **Groundhog Day got its official start in 1887.** Today, thousands of people head to Punxsutawney, Pennsylvania, on February 2 to watch "Phil," the resident groundhog, look for his shadow. Seeing it is said to signal six more weeks of bad weather, scaring the critter back into his hole. If he doesn't see it, it's a sign of spring, and Phil stays above the ground!
